Sheridan Drive Signage: Now that we (finally) received a variance from the Town, we can consider erecting a new sign at the Sheri dan Drive entrance. This will take time to work the details out (ie: design, placement, etc.) so don't expect to see anything for at least a few months!

Rivendell Students Take First Place: Congratulations to the students from Rivendell who came in first place! At a local competition between 11 schools, they gave a "mock up" presentation on how to help alleviate the potential for structural damage caused by snow buildup by utilizing a solar tube on the roof that would melt and drain the water into a gutter and downspout, which would in turn spin a turbine that causes energy to power a battery to help heat the roof-top solar tube.

Annual Pledge Letters: You will be receiving a letter requesting a reply for your financial support. By replying, not only do you help the Budget Committee to do the annual budget but you can also indicate whether or not you want to receive pledge envelopes. Your prompt response will be greatly appreciated. 
FOOD PANTRY: 32 bags of food were donated in December. *Please try to remember* the collection is the **first weekend** of each month. Thank you for your continued support.

done packing at noon.




