### **The Chatter**

#### **SEPTEMBER 2023**

Hello St. Barts Family! I have lately been considering Psalm 84, in particular verse 10 which states, "Better is one day in your courts than thousands elsewhere." Psalm 84 is about how wonderful it is to be in relationship with Almighty God to the point that we eagerly desire to worship Him in His courts.

I can remember when I was young how many of my peers couldn't wait for the worship service to be over so they could get on with whatever else they wanted to do. They didn't have the same desire as the author of Psalm 84. They did not understand how good God is. They did not take their relationship with God seriously.

Such is the attitude of many in society today. They consider relationship with God as being unnecessary if they consider God at all. Many consider attending worship services as vain religion. But that is not the message of Psalm 84.

Psalm 84 shows the heart of someone who takes God and faith seriously. Someone who cannot wait to spend time with the Lord. Someone who knows that spending even one day with the Lord is better than spending a thousand days anywhere else.

We could substitute the word 'day' for 'hour' or any other time increment. It is better to spend our time in the Lord's courts, in His presence, than it is to spend our time anywhere else.

We live in the time period following the cross. We have an even greater understanding of the love God has for us than they did when the Psalm was written. We are blessed to be part of St. Barts. A community of people that take faith in Jesus Christ seriously. However, this Psalm still challenges us to increase how seriously we take our faith and relationship with God. Do we eagerly desire to spend time with the Lord? Do we demonstrate our belief that it is better to spend one day in the Lord's courts than to spend thousands elsewhere?

#### Psalm 84 Quam dilecta!


- 1 How lovely are your dwellings, O Lord God of hosts!






