General Covid-19 Policies

- All Parents, Children, Staff, and Volunteers must answer to the following before entering the church building:
 - I have not registered a fever of 100.4 degrees or higher for the past 24 hours.
 - I have not been in contact with a person with COVID-19 or under observation for COVID-19.
 - I do not have any symptoms of a respiratory infection (cough, sore throat, fever, shortness of breath).
 - I am not in active quarantine status, nor is anyone in my home within active quarantine status.
- All Parents, Children, Staff and Volunteers are required to have their temperatures taken when they arrive at Church. This personal health information will not be recorded
- All adults and children over the age of 2 will enter the church wearing a face mask/covering and will keep it properly in place the entire time they are in the church building.
- Social Distancing will be practiced in the hallways, classrooms, and bathrooms of the building. Students will sit distanced from others at tables or social distance circles
- Parents will need to drop-off and pick up their children from the Sunday School classroom doors and not enter the classroom.
- If a student becomes ill or develops symptoms while attending Sunday School or Youth Group, the student will be isolated until the parents or emergency contacts come to pick them up. If an adult becomes ill or develops symptoms while at Sunday School or Youth Group, they will leave the building immediately. The area in which that person spent time will be cleaned rigorously immediately.

Handling Covid-19 Positive Cases

In the event a parent, child, or staff member, or volunteer tests positive for COVID-19:

- The person must contact the Church immediately. The infected person will remain at home for at least 14 days and the duration of the illness/symptoms. The person must be symptom free for 3 full days before returning to Children or Youth Ministry Activities.
- Those who would have been exposed in potential contact with the infected person will be notified and will remain at home for 14 days. The classrooms/meeting areas would then undergo extensive cleaning. Please realize that sending a child with symptoms may put an entire class or more at risk of shut down, and therefore we need your vigilance to adhere to these health policies.
- The identity of the individual who has Covid-19 is strictly confidential, as required by the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).
